ALDI FIRST TO CUT MILK PRICE

ALDI will take the 11 cent per litre Dairy Adjustment Levy off the price of its milk products across its 204 stores from this Sunday – two weeks earlier than the Government's designated date of 23rd February.

ALDI Stores Group Managing Director, Michael Kloeters said ALDI will fund the levy for the next two weeks as a gesture of goodwill for our customers.

"Times are tough and so by reducing the prices early, it might mean that families can put the savings towards something else," he said.

The Levy was introduced in 2000 to fund the Australian Government's assistance package for farmers after the deregulation of the dairy industry. Late last year, the Federal Government announced it would abolish the 11 cents per litre Dairy Adjustment Levy from Monday 23 February, 2009.

The 11 cents per litre reduction will be effective Sunday 8 February, 2009 across all of ALDI's fresh and UHT milk products.
