- Market Fare Corn Kernels 1kg - Product of Hungary - QLD, VIC, WA and select NSW Stores (Tweed Heads, Grafton, Ballina, Coffs Harbour, Lismore, Lavington, Albury, Casino, Byron Bay, Toormina, Goonellabah & Armidale)
- Market Fare Mixed Vegetables 1kg - Packed in Belgium from Imported and Belgian Ingredients - QLD, NSW (except Albury & Lavington), ACT, WA Stores only
- Market Fare Quick Steam Carrot Broccoli and Cauliflower 450g – All Stores
- Market Fare Quick Steam Carrot Corn and Broccoli 450g – All Stores

Only products with the following country of origin are affected: Belgium, United Kingdom or Hungary. All other countries not affected.

Greenyard Frozen Belgium NV is conducting a recall of the above products. The products have been available for sale at ALDI stores.

Problem: The recall is due to possible microbial (*Listeria monocytogenes*) contamination.

Food safety hazard: *Listeria* may cause illness in pregnant women and their unborn babies, the elderly and people with low immune systems.
